Starting Out

When you first get started, this is how your cart will look. The rest of this guide will explain getting from here to cleaning windows.



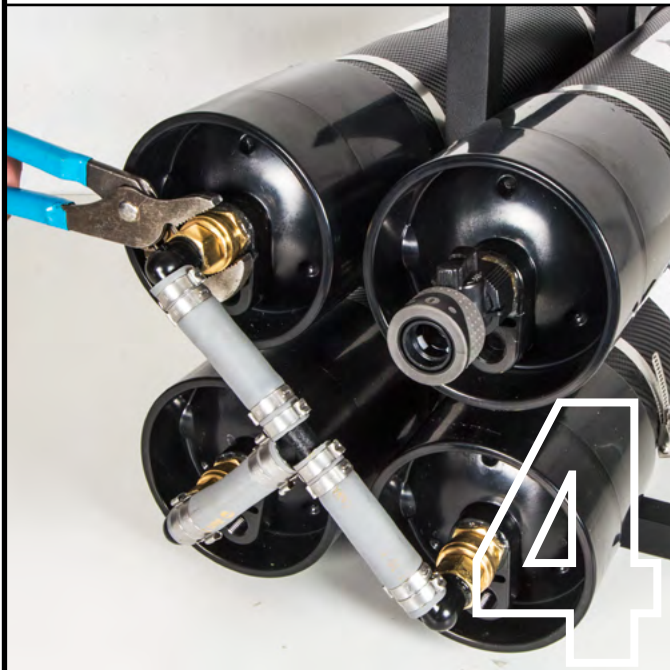
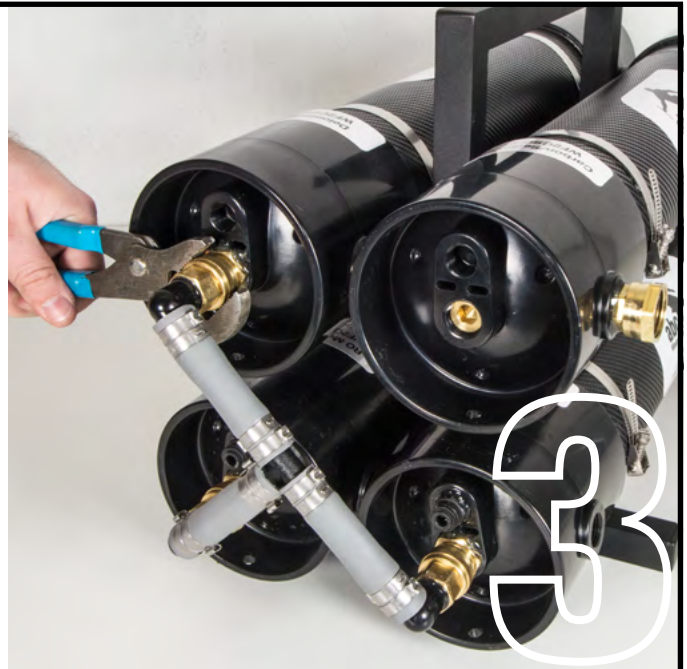
Quick Connect

Screw quick connect valve to DI output.

Input Spider

The crossbar of the “Spider T” connects the upper right fitting to the lower left fitting (diagonally).

The stem of the “Spider T” attaches to the remaining fitting. Tighten with channel locks, but do not over tighten.



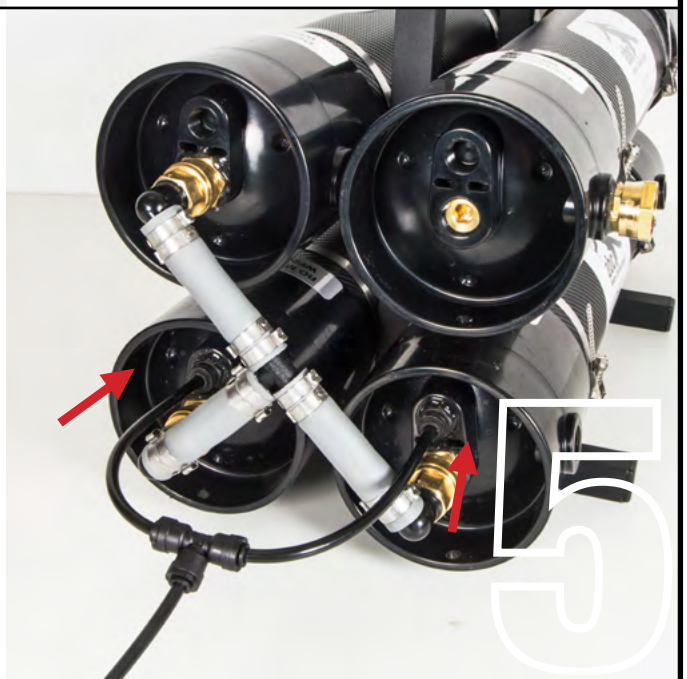
Output Spider

The crossbar of the “Spider T” connects the upper right fitting to the lower left fitting (diagonally).

The stem of the “Spider T” attaches to the remaining fitting. Tighten with channel locks, but do not over tighten.

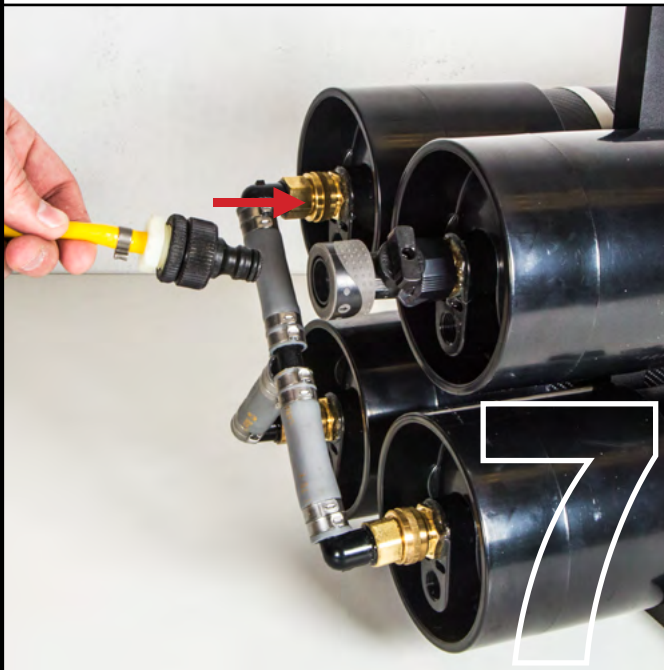
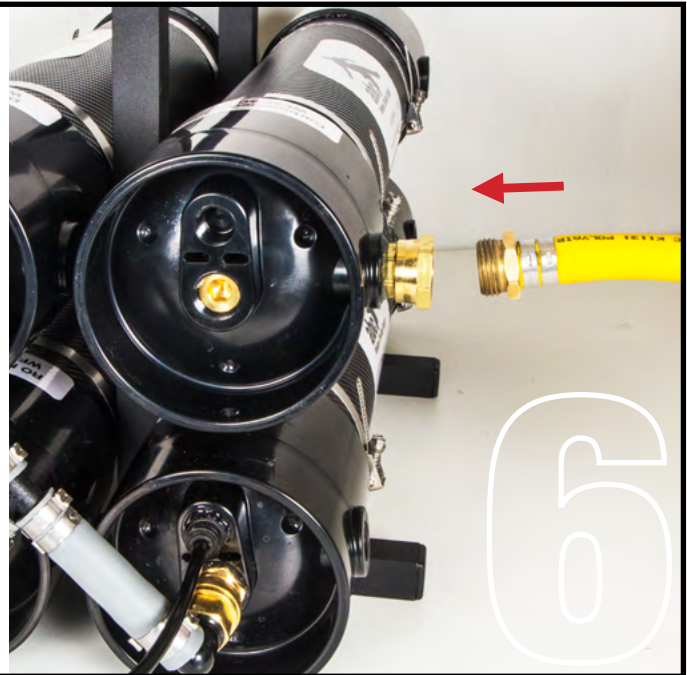
RO Bypass

Insert bypass hose into the two lower canister fittings (the ROs). Make sure they are seated completely.



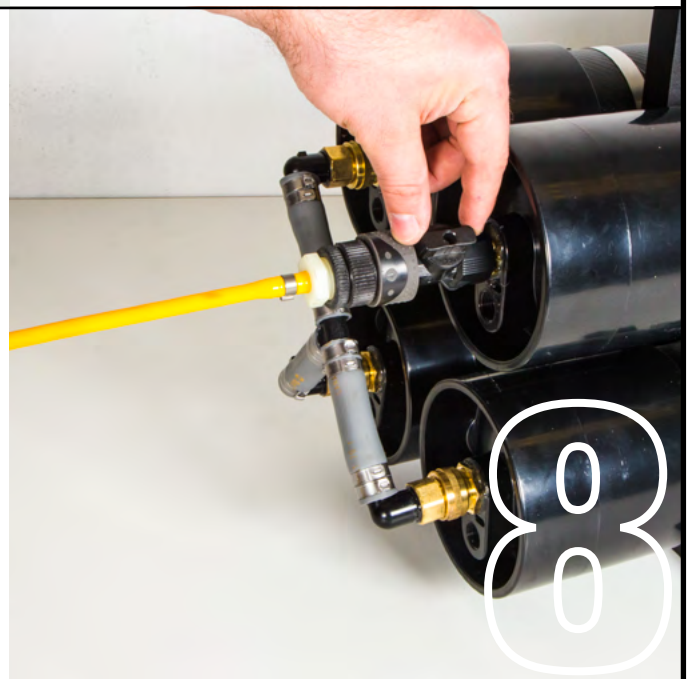
Feed Hose

Connect your water source to the garden hose fitting on the carbon/sediment.



Pole

Make sure the shut off valve is in the off position. Connect your pole using the quick connect/shut off valve provided with your system.



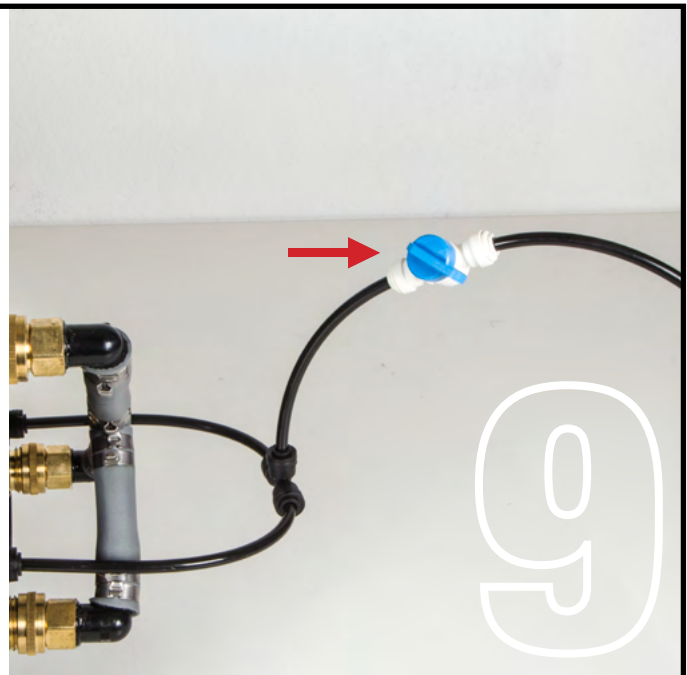
Open Valve

Open the quick connect valve to allow water to flow.

Turn On Water

Close your bypass valve until only a trickle is coming out.

At least some water must be coming out at all times while in use.



Clean Windows

Enjoy your Voyager system!

Shut Down Procedure

When you are done using your system, fully open the *bypass valve* and close the *shut off valve*. This will flush your RO membranes prolonging their life.

Do This for 1-2 minutes.

Turn off water.
